1. A campsite is considered occupied when registration and fee is deposited, receipt is placed on camp post, and site is occupied by a camping unit, i.e., Camper, Tent, Motorhome or Vehicle. If host, or ranger needs to track you down to collect your camping fee, you **WILL** be assessed an extra **\$5.00**.

2. **Speed limit is 5 M.P.H. throughout the park at all times.** Radar is in use & citations may be issued.

3. QUIET HOURS are from **10:30 pm to 6:30 am**. No exceptions. Violators will be asked to leave— with **no** refunds.



4. Two vehicles per electric site (do not park on grass or roadway).

M.P.H. Only one vehicle per non-electric tent site.

Visitors welcome and must park in visitors parking area.

5. RV and one tent per electric site or two tents per electric site if no RV is present. Pay appropriate site fee.

6. No more than two tents per non-electric tent site (\$10.00). T-sites

7. ALL watercraft will be parked in

8. PETS - All pets **must be on a leash**. Owners are responsible for sanitary disposal of pet waste (do **not** leave in fire rings). Dogs are not to be left outside unattended, or bark excessively when left inside. Grassy areas around the park **are not** designated as pet stations. **NO PETS ALLOWED ON BEACH**.

9. No washing vehicles or campers in campground with park water.

10. Remove all trash to dumpsters. Do not leave trash at camping site or in the fire rings.

11. We are **NOT** responsible for accidents, injuries, loss of money, or valuables.

12. **Please be courteous to others.** Do not walk or ride bikes through occupied campsites **at any time**.

13. Scharnberg Park is closed to visitors and drive through traffic between the hours of 10:30 PM to 6:30 AM.

14. No Hard Liquor.

15. No bikes may be ridden after dark unless there is a white lights in front and a red light on the rear.

16. **Bike riding, rollerblading, and skateboarding are not allowed on sidewalks or fishing pier.**

17. Golf carts are allowed in campground and on roads for handicap use only and will have Handicap placard displayed..

18. **For stays lasting longer than 3 days, carpets, rugs and tents must be moved at all campsites to save the grass from dying. We also ask if you are absent from campground for anytime, to roll up your carpets.**

19. Beach is open from sunrise to sunset. Beach attendant only. No life-guard on duty - swim at your own risk. **All beach rules will also be posted at concession stand.**

20. **Beach Rules are as follows:**

A) No profanity

B) No throwing rocks or sand

C) Stay off buoys

D) Swim in buoyed area ONLY

E) Pick up your own litter

F) No dogs or other pets allowed on beach

G) No hard liquor

H) No glass on or near beach (I.E. stone wall)
